ENEL GREEN POWER: NEW WIND FARM ENTERS SERVICE IN ITALY

The Bagaladi Motta Montebello plant in Calabria has a capacity of 28 MW and will be able to generate more than 50 million kWh per year once fully operational.

Rome, February 7th, 2013 – Enel Green Power has connected to the grid the new wind farm located in Bagaladi, in the province of Reggio Calabria.

The Bagaladi Motta Montebello wind farm is comprised of 33 turbines of 0.85 MW each, for a total installed capacity of 28 MW. Once fully operational, the wind farm will be able to generate more than 50 million kWh each year.

With the addition of the Bagaladi Motta Montebello wind farm, EGP's wind installed capacity in Italy is now over 700 MW.

EGP, the Enel Group company dedicated to the development and management of renewable energy sources in Italy and abroad, has a domestic total installed capacity of approximately 3,000 MW from a mix of different technologies.
