AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 12 AUGUST 2014 FOR THE PROPOSED 140 MEGAWATTS (MW) KARUSA WIND ENERGY FACILITY (PHASE 1) AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE ON THE FARM DE HOOP 202, THE FARM STANDVASTIGHEID 201, AND THE REMAINDER OF THE FARM RHEEBOKKE FONTEIN 209 AND PORTION 3 OF THE FARM RHEEBOKKE FONTEIN 2019, WITHIN THE KAROO HOOGLAND LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the abovementioned application by this Department on 12 August 2014, the first amendment to the EA dated 03 May 2016, the second amendment to the EA dated 04 November 2016, and your application for amendment of the EA received by the Department on 11 April 2017 refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended on 07 April 2017, has decided to amend the EA dated 12 August 2014, as follows:

Amendment 1: Amendment to extend the validity period of the EA:

The activity must commence within a period of two (02) years from the date of expiry of the EA issued on 12 August 2014 (i.e. the EA lapses on 12 August 2019). If commencement of the activity does not occur within that period, the authorisation lapses and a new application for environmental authorisation must be made in order for the activity to be undertaken.

The applicant applied to extend the validity period of the EA as the above-mentioned development was awarded preferred bidder status in May 2015 during round four of the bidding window. Construction was meant to commence after financial close was achieved, of which the target was Quarter 2 of 2016. However, as a result of delays to the process imposed by Eskom and Department of Energy (DoE) under the REIPPPP, construction has not yet commence and hence the request for extension.

This amendment letter must be read in conjunction with the EA dated 12 August 2014, as amended.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (the Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's decision in respect of your application as well as the fact that an appeal may be lodged against the decision in terms of the National Appeals Regulations, and the provisions regarding the submission of appeals as contained in the Regulations.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable
